Ash Wednesday (February 18) Schedule

On Ash Wednesday there will be a special collection for the benefit of the NORTHERN MISSIONS in our archdiocese. While the needs are great elsewhere in the world, we have a personal responsibility for the missions in our own backyard. Envelopes for this collection are in with your regular envelopes, or there will be extra available in the entrance to the church on Wednesday.

Lent has two major purposes: it recalls or prepares for baptism and it emphasizes a spirit of penance. In support of these two purposes each Friday during Lent (except March 6, World Day of Prayer and April 3, Good Friday) you are invited to participate in a special Lenten meal with a reflection on a social justice theme, followed by the Stations of the Cross. A simple meatless soup will be served in Tranquille Hall by the CWL beginning at 6:00 pm. The reflection will be around 6:20 pm. At 7:00 pm the Stations of the Cross will begin in the church. Join us for either or both events, whichever your time allows.

The first evening is Friday, Feb. 20. The Social Justice group will be speaking on "Sow Much Love" which is D&P's Theme for this Lenten season.

Stations of the Cross in the church will be lead by the Social justice Group. Everyone is welcome.



In today's second reading, St. Paul urges the Corinthians to "do all for the glory of God." If we follow that advice in everything we do, we cannot help but be good stewards!

ADULT FORMATION

Ash Wednesday (February 18) & Good Friday, (April 3) are universal days of fasting and abstinence from meat. The law of abstinence from meat binds those who are 14 years of age and older; the law of fasting binds those who are 18 to 59 years of age. The church does not encourage a "black fast" which implies eating nothing. The fast we are invited to observe is to limit ourselves to one ordinary meal (perhaps more simple than usual) and much more simple meals at other times. Ash Wednesday is a good day to make an effort to refrain from snacking. The purpose of fasting is to learn to discipline ourselves and to be in solidarity with so many around the world who have much less that we have. Fasting is never intended to harm your health!! If you have a medical condition in which you must eat certain foods at certain times, or are pregnant or nursing a child, please continue with what you ordinarily eat. Do not compromise your health.

LENT AND LITURGY Since Lent is intended to be a time that we live life more simply in order to focus on what is more pressing in our life, our liturgy adapts slightly as well. You will notice that we do not sing the Gloria or Alleluia during Lent. These are both joyous in tone and appropriate for most of the year but not so much during a liturgical season that is penitential in nature. By the end of Lent we will appreciate all the more Alleluia and The Gloria after we have fasted from them for these weeks of Lent.
