Bulletin Q & A - Mastering the Mass

Q. What is the significance of the Altar?

A. This is the principal table in a church building, the focal point for the sacramental presence of Christ during the celebration of the Mass. The altar may have an altar stone that holds the relics of a saint. When a bishop consecrates an altar, he traces five crosses upon the table with the oil of Chrism, one in each of the four corners and in the centre.
