If you are unable to get to Mass on the weekend, please ask someone to pick up tickets on your behalf.

Bulletin Q & A - Mastering the Mass

Q. What is the significance of the Processional Cross and the Processional Candles?

A. The processional cross is a crucifix carried at the head of the procession in a celebration (unless incense is used). Two servers carrying processional candles accompany the cross bearer. The candles shed light on the unfolding paschal mystery.
