Bulletin Q & A - Mastering the Mass

Q. What is the significance of the Altar Candles? **A.** These candles are ideally placed on or near the altar and are lit at the beginning of every Eucharist. There have to be at least two, but four to six are allowed and even seven when a bishop is present. The candles give light to what is actually happening on the altar.
