During Lent we are not scheduling baptisms.

Lent has two major purposes: It recalls or prepares for baptism and emphasizes a spirit of penance. For the six weeks of Lent we are in the desert preparing for new life - the resurrection. Baptism is when we first encounter new life with Jesus. Therefore, it is not appropriate to celebrate baptism *during* Lent as we are *preparing* for baptism. We will resume celebrating baptisms on Easter Sunday, April 21.

FYI - the ashes on Ash Wednesday come from the Palms used on Palm Sunday last year. In preparation for Ash Wednesday we invite you to bring your old palm branches to church before **Sunday**, **February 22** so that we have time to burn them before Ash Wednesday.

Q. What is the Chasuble?

A. It is the 'poncho-like' outer liturgical vestment worn by priests and bishops when celebrating the Eucharist. This outer garment reflects the liturgical season in its colour and often includes other artwork that depicts various aspects of the Paschal Mystery.
