Bulletin Q & A - Mastering the Mass

Q. What are the Liturgical Colours?

A. These are the colours the Church uses that change with the seasons of the Church's year.

<u>White</u>: Trinity Sunday; Feasts of Christ and Mary; Corpus Christi; Feasts of Virgins and Confessors; funerals.

<u>Red</u>: Pentecost; Feasts of Apostles and Martyrs;

Palm Sunday; Good Friday

<u>Green</u>: Sundays and Ordinary Days from Epiphany to Lent and from Trinity Sunday to Advent

Purple: Lent and Advent.
