Mass with Anointing of the Sick, Thursday, May 16 at 1:00 pm - a special opportunity for those who wish to receive the Sacrament of the Sick. In the past this sacrament was called *Extreme Unction* and was reserved for those who were approaching death. Today, the Sacrament of the Sick is available for anyone who has a serious illness: the elderly whose frailty is becoming more pronounced, major surgery/serious medical tests, an uncontrollable and chronic illnesses (arthritis, diabetes, etc.), mental illness. If you know of anyone who would benefit from this sacrament or is homebound because of infirmity, please help them to attend this Mass.

Bulletin Q & A - Mastering the Mass

Q. What is the significance of Incense?

A. The burning of incense in religious ceremonies is a symbol of prayer and worship of God that goes back to ancient times. Sacred objects are often incensed during our liturgies, e.g. the altar, the people, the body of a deceased person at funeral Masses, the Easter candle, the Book of Gospels.
