Corpus Christi The Feast of The Body and Blood of Christ Sunday, June 23. In many places around the world there is a Eucharistic Procession on this day. This is a reminder that when we receive the Body and Blood of Christ we are called to take Christ to the world. On June 23 we will have Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament beginning at 2:00 pm. At 2:50 we will process around the front of the church and conclude with Benediction near the bell tower.

Feast of Our Mother of Perpetual Help, June 27

The icon of our Mother of Perpetual Help has a prominent place in our church and chapel. This icon was given to the Redemptorist Order by the Pope over 100 years ago with the instruction to "make her known." Please join the parish for Mass Thursday, June 27 at 7:00 pm as we celebrate this Feast. *This year, for the first time we will celebrate a Perpetual Help Triduum* in preparation for the feast. We will gather on Tuesday, June 25 and Wednesday, June 26 before the evening Mass when we will have Perpetual Help prayers and a short reflection. Please join us for all three evenings.

Bulletin Q & A - Mastering the Mass

Q. What is the Sprinkling Rite; why is it used? **A.** It is the blessing and sprinkling of holy water upon the congregation. Especially at Easter time it may replace the Penitential Rite as a reminder of our Baptism. When the priest blesses us with holy water, we make the sign of the cross.
