Voting as Catholics - 2019 Federal Election Guide

It highlights many values that we need to keep in mind as we prepare to vote, including respect for life, dignity of the human person, concern for the weakest among us, solidarity and dialogue with different social partners, justice and peace, and respect for the planet, our common home.
